

CAPITAL STRATEGY

Thornbury Town Council has carefully evaluated its approach to managing assets in alignment with our strategic priorities, ensuring that community needs are met while maintaining financial responsibility. Our Capital Strategy is structured around two key asset categories: amenities and buildings. Within these categories, projects have been prioritised based on their importance and anticipated impact on the community, with all projects considering Strategic Priority 1 - to deliver the Council's commitment to tackle the climate emergency.

To clearly align projects with our strategic objectives, we have used a colour-coding system that links each project to its respective strategic priority, making it easy to see how each project supports our overall goals.

Each project has been assigned a provisional start and end date; however, these timelines are subject to change due to various influencing factors. This document is intended to be a dynamic resource, subject to ongoing updates as projects progress and as actual data becomes available.

The funding for these projects will be drawn from a diverse range of sources, including Grants, Capital Reserves, the Community Infrastructure Levy, and the Precept. Additionally, the Town Council may consider applying for a Public Works Loan to finance specific initiatives where necessary. Recognising the long-term nature of some projects, we have also incorporated a prudent budgeting approach for ongoing maintenance to ensure sustainable management of our assets.
