The village shop is run entirely by volunteers. We celebrated 20 years of business in June 2018.

There is a seven days-a-week daily newspaper service staffed by a dedicated team from 7:00 till 8:30 am six days-a-week and an hour later on Sundays.

If there is a particular item or request that you have, ask anyone at the counter and a message can be given to the ordering team. We will do our best to stock/order them.

Should you wish to join our friendly team of volunteers do please ask anyone behind the counter in the shop. Your help would be really welcome. There are behind the scenes jobs if you do not want to serve behind the counter.

Serving in the shop is an excellent way to meet new people and feel part of the community that is Tytherington Village. You can also join the shop association which gives you voting rights at the AMM.

Hobbs House Bakery, Monday/Friday

Hobbs provide us with bread and rolls twice a week. Speciality breads, croissants and pastries may also be ordered in. Orders need to be given before 9am Wednesday for a Friday delivery and 9am Friday for Monday delivery.

Cottage Bakery, Wednesday

Cottage Bakery bring pies and pasties as well as bread on a Wednesday. A selection of cakes/pastries may also be ordered. Please order by 9am Monday for Wednesday delivery.

Halls Bakery, at least once a week.

Halls Bakery provide sliced bread, flapjacks and American muffins. Please ask if you have a special request. These will take at least 48 hours to be delivered.

Patsy's Cakes, Wednesday Mornings.

We have a standing order from Patsy's cakes, though orders can be taken to guarantee your cake requirements. She can also provide Easter biscuits and a small selection of tray bakes. These must be ordered before Monday 9am.

Frocester Fayre, Meat Products.

Meat, Bacon, Ham and frozen ready meals and pasties are available from Thursday afternoon. Again items can be ordered and put aside for you. Please order by Tuesday 5pm for a Thursday collection.

Ferrantes, Sliced Meats and Cheese.

Bacon, ham and cheddar are regularly ordered from Ferrantes. Their delivery also comes in on a Thursday afternoon. Again please order by Tuesday 5pm.

Milk: SMS Monday - Friday Cotteswold - Friday

Milk comes in daily but should you have a particular request e.g. skimmed milk or other dairy items such as yogurt or cream please let us know. You will need to ask by 9am to ensure next day delivery but more notice would be welcome.

Tytherington village shop also has a large car park and easy level access.

Tytherington Post Office



The Post Office is run as a completely separate service within the village shop. Paid staff ensure that this outreach office is run to the given professional standards required. The Postmaster is Phil Coward.

The Post Office service is partly paid for by a parish precept in your council tax as an essential village service.

We have worked hard to provide a daily service, but this does mean the hours are different some days. It is open five mornings.

The more you use the service the more it is likely to continue.

You can pay in and withdraw money from most bank accounts via the Post Office, as well as other post office counter services.
